Safer Neighbourhood policing – “What does it mean and what do they do?” Safer Neighbourhood Teams (SNT’s) were introduced in every ward in London in April 2006. The idea is “Local officers, policing a local area and dealing with its’ residents and the problems that directly concern them”

Every SNT is made up of 1 Sergeant, 2 Police Constables and 3 Community Support Officers. There are alternative ways of reporting low-level crime to the police that may avoid you having to queue at a police station. Visit www.met.police.uk and see the link for self-reporting crime over the internet. It’s quick and easy and you will immediately receive a Home Office reference number.



JUNE CRIME FIGURES

There were 70 incidents / crime allegations reported to police that occurred within the ward of Fullwell.

The incidents of note are as follows;

MOTORBIKES

Now the summer months are upon us there have been a few reported incidents of youths on motor bikes in Claybury woods and the associated park area off Ravensbourne Gardens.

We are working closely with Fairlop SN Policing Team who cover this area and the local authority Parks Police in order to effectively address this issue.

Any motor bikes found at the location will be confiscated and can ultimately be "CRUSHED"
