FULLWELL CRIME FOR MAY 2010

During the month of MAY 2010 there were 106 incidents of crime reported to police relating to Fullwell Ward.

BURGLARY

During MAY there were 5 residential burglaries, 2 attempted burglaries (where no entry was gained) and 3 non - residential burglaries.

CRIME PREVENTION

Now that the summer is upon us, please try to remember to lock and secure your windows and doors.

50% of Burglaries in Redbridge occur at addresses where the occupier has left a door or a window unlocked.



ARRESTS AND OTHER MATTERS

During the Month of May 2010 Fullwell Safer Neighbourhoods Police Officers arrested 8 people for offences such as Burglary, Kidnapping, Theft, Assault and Breach of Curfew.

We have also dealt with 7 People who were “found” in possession of Cannabis issuing them with Formal Warnings or £80.00 Fixed Penalty Notices.

We have issued 5 Fixed Penalty Notices for traffic offences and 3 for people who were riding a pedal cycle on the footway in a dangerous manner. We have Stopped, Accounted and / or Searched 190 people within Fullwell Ward during the month of May.

We have also hand delivered whilst on patrol over 2000 of these Monthly Newsletters across the Ward.

FALLING CRIME IN FULLWELL WARD

**Between 01/05/2006 and 01/05/2007
(The 1st year of SN policing in Fullwell)
there were 1706 Crimes reported
which equates to approximately 4.6
crimes a day.**

**Between 01/05/2009 and 01/05/2010
there were 1005 reported crimes
which equates to approximately 2.7
crimes a day.**

**Over the same period there has been
a reduction in Burglaries within
Fullwell from 193 in 06/07 to 143 in
09/10.**

**The above is an example of what can
be achieved through the introduction
of Neighbourhood Watch Schemes,
the vigilance of local residents and
the willingness to report suspicious
activity to a dedicated and proactive
Safer Neighbourhoods police Team.**

**With the above in mind please
continue to keep “us” informed of any
suspicious behaviour.**
