The FULLWELL Safer Neighbourhood team is aiming to improve the quality of life of people who live and work within Fullwell Ward. We are striving to make the ward a safer place and cut residential burglary.

You can help to reduce the risk by using locks that you already have, securing doors further by fitting stronger locks and being MORE vigilant. Also it is a good idea to fit a letterbox cage to prevent persons from reaching through. This is backed up by making sure all windows and doors are locked and secured whilst out of the house and during the night. Please also lock away or secure all garden tools so as to ensure YOU are not a victim of crime.

Most burglaries are carried out by opportunists. In around 20% of all burglaries, they don't even have to use force; they enter through an unlocked door or window

# FULLWELL CRIME FOR APRIL 2010

During the month of APRIL 2010 there were 80 incidents of crime reported to police relating to Fullwell Ward.

#### **BURGLARY**

Burglary remains a Public Set Priority within Fullwell Ward. Your SN policing Team are working daily to reduce incidents of burglary and reducing opportunities through providing local residents (where identified) with practical crime prevention advice, property marking pens, low energy light bulbs and timers.

During APRIL there were 4 residential burglaries, 2 attempted burglaries (where no entry was gained) and 1 non - residential burglary.

### **WARD PANEL AGM**

Fullwell ward panel held its annual general meeting during the month of April and amongst other things it was agreed that the current priorities around Burglary, Tiptree Estate and State Mansions should remain.

The above priorities will be reviewed in 3 months.

Fullwell Safer Neighbourhoods Policing
Team has also adopted a <u>further</u>
identified problem at Wensleydale
Avenue where organised "Fly Tipping"
is occurring.

We have met (on site) with Councillor Moth, LBR "Street Scene", LBR Planning, The Environmental Agency and numerous local residents. As a result a multi-agency investigation lead by the local authority is underway.
