Fullwell Crime for October 2010

During the month of October there have been 79 incidents of crime reported to police occurring within Fullwell Ward.

Burglary.

During the month of October there were 8 Residential Burglaries.

We are working hard in an attempt to reduce occurrences of Burglary by targeted policing within areas of concern. We are targeting those individuals known to police for Burglary and theft related offences making their lives uncomfortable in doing so. We still however need your help - please be vigilant and report suspicious behaviour to police.

Theft of / Theft from Motor Vehicle.

During October there were 4 vehicles stolen, 6 vehicles broken into and 6 vehicles criminally damaged within Fullwell Ward.

On Frosty mornings please **<u>DO NOT</u>** leave your vehicle running and unattended whilst de-frosting the windscreen as it may get stolen.

Officers attached to Fullwell SNT are carrying **NIKUREG** "Anti Theft" screws in order to distribute them to members of the public whilst on patrol. If you require some of these innovative screws for your number plates then please stop "us" and request a set.

High Street, Barkingside.

It is our intention to increase Police presence within The High Street and immediate locality over the next 3 months. We aim to provide a visible presence in order to deter those considering committing



crime and to react immediately in order to deal with those that do. We hope that our increased visible presence will reduce any fear of crime you may have and make your shopping experience in the High Street a more enjoyable one.

Christmas is coming!

As the nights draw in and it gets darker please remember to be vigilant of those around you. Please remove <u>ALL</u> valuables from your car when unattended.

Keep all your windows and doors locked and secure at home. Burglaries and thefts tend to increase over the run up to Christmas as "shoppers" purchase gifts prior to the event. Don't let your hard earned money buy gifts that will end up under a Burglars Christmas tree.

Arrests and Other Matters

Officers from Fullwell SNT arrested 4 people during the month of October for offences of Theft and Public Order committed with Fullwell Ward. We have also issued 4 Cannabis Warnings, 2 Fixed Penalty Tickets and executed a search warrant for drugs. We have also issued at total of 30 Fixed Penalty Notices for Traffic related offences.
